	Angela	Mid July	Large, glossy black-red fruit with red flesh; good flavor.	Vigorous, heavy producer; good crack resistance	Pollinate with any other cherry on this list.
	Bing	Mid June Early July	Large, dark red fruit with reddish-purple flesh; firm and meaty.	Well known, popular cherry; susceptible to cracking	Pollinate with any other cherry on this list.
	Black Gold	June	Large, moderately firm dark red fruit with dark purple flesh and good flavor.	Crack resistant, late bloomer (frost hardy), heavy producer	Self-fertile. Good pollinizer for other cherries.
	Carmine Jewel	July	Medium sized, purplish-red fruit; sweet-tart flavor.	True dwarf w/Mongolian & Tart cherry parents; large crops for fresh, jellies & pies	Self fertile. Good pollinizer for other cherries.
	Early Burlat	May/June	Large, sweet, dark red, flavorful. Medium firm fruit.	Very productive. Resistant to canker; susceptible to cracking.	Pollinate with any other cherry on this list.
	Glacier	June	Large, dark red fruit; very flavorful, sweet.	Crack resistant. Developed at WSU	Self-fertile Good pollinizer for other cherries.
	Kristin	Mid July	Large, glossy dark red fruit; firm, meaty and juicy red flesh	Super cold-hardy; reliable producer, crack resistant	Pollinate with any other cherry on this list.
	Lapins	Late July	Large deep red firm fruit w/ purple-red meaty flesh; rich, aromatic, sweet flavor	Originated in Canada. Heavy producer; crack resistant; Pink blossoms.	Self-fertile. Good pollinizer for other cherries.
	Montmorency	June/July	Medium sized, bright red fruit with firm yellow flesh. Tart, tangy flavor.	The standard for pie cherries; Heavy bearer; great for canning. Good disease resistance.	Self-fertile. Good pollinizer for other cherries.
	Morello	July/ August	Large dark red fruit; juicy, crimson flesh. Tart aromatic flavor.	Centuries old English variety. Dark red juice. Small tree habit w/ drooping branches.	Self-fertile. Good pollinizer for other cherries.
	Rainier	Late July	Large yellow fruit w/ red blush; firm, sweet fruit.	Productive, vigorous tree; crack resistant	Pollinate with any other cherry on this list.

 Sam	Early July	Large, black red fruit; firm and juicy	Developed in Canada. Good producer, some crack resistance	Pollinate with any other cherry on this list.
 Stella	June	Large blackish-red fruit w/ flavorful sweet, juicy flesh.	Productive. Crack resistant.	Self-fertile.
 Sweetheart	Late July	Large bright red fruit with excellent flavor.	Good producer. Crack resistant. Remains firm.	Self-fertile.
 Tehranivee	Late July	Large mahogany fruit; dark red flesh; sweet and firm w/ good flavor.	Upright grower from Canada. Some crack resistance.	Self-fertile.
 Van	July	Med-large ruby-red fruit similar to Bing, but slightly more tart.	Strong vigorous tree; Good annual producer. Crack resistant.	Pollinate with any other cherry on this list.
 Vandalay	July	Medium to large wine red fruit with good sweet flavor.	Developed in Canada. Spreading habit. Canker and crack resistant.	Self-fertile.

PLUERRY VARIETIES 2023

Pluerries are complex fruit hybrids, mainly from Japanese plums and cherries. They have predominantly plum heritage with fruit resembling plums and tasting closer to cherries. They are newer, so if you try one out, let us know what you think!!

 Candy Heart Pluerry	August September	Dark speckled red skin w/ amber-red flesh; "slightly subacid and very sweet, with a wonderfully unique flavor"	Heart shaped fruit slightly smaller than a golf ball; extended "hang time"	Pollinate with another Pluerry or Burgundy Plum
 Sugar Twist Pluerry	July	Red fruit with yellow flesh. Complex flavor "cherry sweet with a plum twist".	Newest pluerry; ripens a month earlier than Sweet Treat.	Pollinate with another Pluerry, Flavor King Pluot or Burgundy Plum
 Sweet Treat Pluerry	July August	"Combines the sweetness of a cherry with that summer fresh plum zing"	"This precocious and prolific variety will hang on the tree for over a month"	Pollinate with another Pluerry Flavor King Pluot or Burgundy Plum
