 <b>Anjou</b>	Late Sept/ Early October	Scab Susceptible	Green pear; Juicy, aromatic, mild sweet spicy flavor with fine flesh. Good all-purpose pear, fresh & cooking.	Store 4 to 6 weeks Ripen at room temperature Keeps until spring	Pollinate with any other European Pear on this list
 <b>Bartlett</b>	September	Scab Susceptible	Large, smooth green-yellow pear with soft, sweet, aromatic flesh. Great for canning.	Keeps about 4 to 6 weeks	Pollinate with any other European Pear on this list
 <b>Early Gold</b>	Early September	Scab Susceptible	Small high quality green/yellow fruit. Sweet, crisp, with white flesh. Good for fresh eating, cooking, baking.	Keeps about 4 weeks	Pollinate with any other European Pear on this list
 <b>Orcas</b>	Late August/ Early Sept	Scab Resistant	Large red blushed pear; Sweet, mild flavor. All-purpose pear; discovered on Orcas Island; perfect for growing in the PNW.	Keeps about 4 to 6 weeks	Pollinate with any other European pear on this list
 <b>Rescue</b>	September	Scab Resistant	Very large, attractive, yellow fruit with reddish orange blush.	Store until December	Pollinate with any other European pear on this list
 <b>Ubileen</b>	August	Scab Resistant	Large greenish fruit with red blush. Juicy sweet, fine texture, aromatic. Vigorous and productive tree, one of first pears to ripen.	Keeps about 4 to 6 weeks	Pollinate with any other European pear on this list

 <b>Orange</b>	September	Good producer of large bright yellow fruit and orange flesh. Good for preserves & baking.		Self Fertile
 <b>Pineapple</b>	Late Sept/Oct	Medium large round fruit, ripens from green to golden, lemon yellow & very aromatic. Flesh is firm & dry with mix of apple, pear & pineapple flavor. Great for cooking & jelly.		Self- Fertile
 <b>Smyrna</b>	Sept/Oct	Large lemon yellow fragrant fruit with excellent flavored tender flesh. Good for storage, preserves & baking.		Self Fertile

 <b>Chojuro</b>	Mid September	Scab Resistant	Flattened, medium size brown russeted fruit. Crisp juicy white flesh, mild and slightly aromatic. Keeps all winter, eat fresh off tree. Thin fruits in early summer for best fruit production.	Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list
 <b>Hosui</b>	September	Scab Resistant	Medium to large, rounded, brownish yellow fruit. Juicy, sweet/tart, crisp, fine textured. Stores thru December.	Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list
 <b>Kousi</b>	Early August	Scab Resistant	Small to medium yellow fruit with bronze russeting. Sweet taste, crisp and juicy. Stores thru September. Thin fruits for best fruit production.	Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list
 <b>Maxie</b>	September	Scab Resistant	European x Asian pear cross. Rounded fruit, yellow/gold with a red blush. Crisp, juicy & sweet with Bartlett type flavor.	Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list
 <b>Nijesseiki</b>	Mid September	Scab Resistant	Rounded, green-yellow pear with mild, sweet/tart flavor. Firm and juicy white flesh. Also known as '20th Century Pear'. Thin for best fruit production.	Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list.
 <b>Shinglo</b>	Early August	Scab Resistant	Medium, golden brown skin. Sweet, juicy, excellent flavor.	Pollinate with any other Asian Pear on this list.
 <b>Shinseiki</b>	Mid August	Scab Resistant	Bright yellow fruit. Sweet, juicy, refreshing flavor. Good heavy producer, fruit keeps well.	Self-pollinating
