## CURRENTS

(Self-fertile, High in Vit C, Easy to grow!)

Variety	Color/Type	Flavor	Features	Uses
<b>Cherry Red</b>	Red	Tart, acid flavor	4 to 6 feet	Jams, jellies, sauces
<b>Consort</b>	Black	Very strong, sweet musky flavor	4 to 6 feet	Jams & jellies, juice & wine, dried
<b>Crandall</b>	Black	Sweet tart, more mild	3 to 4 feet	Jams & jellies, syrups & juice
<b>Primus</b>	White	Sweet, long clusters	4 to 6 feet	Jams & jellies, syrups & juice
<b>Red Lake</b>	Red	Flavorful, tart, prolific	4 to 5 feet	Jams & jellies, syrups & juice

## GOOSEBERRIES

(Self-fertile, High in Vit C)

<b>Little Ben</b>	Red	Sweet, flavorful with tart skin	Disease resistant; Productive, small shrub	Fresh eating, syrup, jams
<b>Black Velvet</b>	Reddish-black	Sweet, blueberrylike flavor	Vigorous plant, disease resistant	Fresh eating, pies, jams
<b>Pixwell</b>	Pink	Sweet-tart	Very successful, Disease resistant	Fresh eating, pies, preserves, and sweet-tart wine
<b>Captivator</b>	Red	Large, sweet when ripe	Nearly thornless cane, Disease resistant	Fresh eating, pies, and preserves

## JOSTABERRY:

**Black Currant X Gooseberry Cross** (Self-fertile, High in Vit C)

<b>Jostine Jostaberry</b>	Reddish-black	Mild black-currant flavor	Upright shrub; thornless; disease-resistant	Excellent jam, juice, fresh eating
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## ELDERBERRIES 2023

**These varieties may be cooked to make syrups, jams, and wines.  
(Raw elderberries are not edible and can cause nausea and vomiting.)  
(Please note: our native *Red* elderberries are poisonous and should not be eaten.)**

Variety	Harvest	Features	Uses	Pollination
<b>Nova</b>	August	Almost black clusters of sweet tasty berries.	Juice, syrup, wine, jam. Great for wildlife.	Pollinate with any other Elderberry on the list.
<b>York</b>	September	Clusters of very large purplish sweet tart berries.	Juice, syrup, wine, jam. Great for wildlife.	Pollinate with any other Elderberry on the list.

## OTHER BERRIES

<b>Choke-Berry</b>	Sept/Oct	Wine-black, tannic berries; high in anti-oxidants; tolerant of wet soils; excellent autumn color.	Fresh, preserves, wine, baking, wildlife.	Self-fertile
<b>Goji Berry</b>	Sept/Oct	Sweet/sour; high in anti-oxidants, vitamins and minerals	Fresh, juice, smoothies, teas, dried	Self-fertile
<b>Dwarf Mulberry</b>	Summer	Sweet, juicy, black berries; Compact, long-lived tree or shrub; Dark fruit will stain surfaces.	Fresh, frozen, jam, juice & wine.	Self-fertile
