FILBERT / HAZELNUT

Variety	Eastern Filbert Blight Resistance	Nut Description	Pollination	Comments
Jefferson	Immune	Large nut with well-filled shells; buttery flavor profile	Late season. Would benefit from two different pollinators.	Upright growth; train to a single trunk; vigorous.
Polly O	Highly resistant	Good quality, medium-size rounded nuts. Good texture and flavor.	Pollinate with Wepster	Early nut maturity; good for use in chocolate & baked goods. Vigorous tree.
Sacajawea	Somewhat Resistant	Medium-large nuts with great flavor similar to Italian cultivars.	Pollinate with Jefferson or York.	Nuts mature earlier. Good yields w/ few blanks. Developed by OSU.
Wepster	Immune	Very good kernel quality, high yields of small-medium sized nuts	Mid-season. Pollinate with York or Yamhill	Early nut maturity, high tree vigor, easy to train as single trunk trees.
Yamhill	Immune	Very good quality, texture, flavor and appearance. Thin-shelled, round, with little fiber.	Pollinate with Jefferson and other late season varieties.	Compact, spreading growth habit for good light penetration; Tree anchorage is strong. Very productive.

Variety	Disease Resistance/ Hardiness	Nut Description	Pollination	Comments
Carpathian	Pest & Disease Resistant	Plump, thin-shelled. Full-flavored, excellent quality.	Pollinate with Cascade	Slightly smaller but more hardy, fast-growing, symmetrical, spreading, tree. Bears in 5-7 yrs.
Cascade	Very cold hardy	Large, thin-shelled with excellent buttery flavor.	Pollinate with Carpathian	Productive, heavy-bearing tree. Rate #1 by North American Nut Grower Assn.
