Cherry Red	Red	Tart, acid flavor	4 to 6 feet	Jams, jellies, sauces
Consort	Black	Very strong, sweet musky flavor	4 to 6 feet	Jams & jellies, juice & wine, dried
Crandall	Black	Sweet tart, more mild	3 to 4 feet	Jams & jellies, syrups & juice
Red Lake	Red	Flavorful, tart, prolific	4 to 5 feet	Jams & jellies, syrups & juice
Primus	White	Sweet, long clusters	4 to 6 feet	Jams & jellies, syrups & juice

GOOSEBERRIES

(Self-fertile, High in Vit C)

Black Velvet	Reddish-black	Sweet, blueberry-like flavor	Vigorous plant, disease resistant	Fresh eating, pies, jams
Jeanne	Maroon Red	Sweet, full-flavored	Productive, excellent disease-resistance	Desserts, juices, jams
Little Ben	Red	Sweet, flavorful with tart skin	Productive, disease resistant, small shrub	Fresh eating, syrup, jams
Oregon Champion	Yellow Green	Sweetens as they ripen	Vigorous, upright small shrub	Fresh eating, pies, preserves, wine, dried
Pixwell	Pinkish green	Medium sized; Superb flavor	Vigorous, upright shrub, less thorns	Delicious for fresh eating, pies and preserves

ELDERBERRIES 2022

These varieties may be cooked to make syrups, jams, and wines.

(Raw elderberries are not edible and can cause nausea and vomiting.)

(Please note: our native *Red* elderberries are poisonous and should not be eaten.)

Adams	Aug/Sept	Large clusters of dark purple to black berries.	Juice, syrup, wine, jam. Great for wildlife.	Pollinate with any other Elderberry on the list.
Bob Gordon	Aug/Sept	Taller with larger & sweeter dark purple berries. Tolerates poor soils; wet/drought tolerant.	Juice, syrup, wine, jam. Great for wildlife.	Pollinate with any other Elderberry on the list.
Nova	August	Almost black clusters of sweet tasty berries.	Juice, syrup, wine, jam. Great for wildlife.	Pollinate with any other Elderberry on the list.
Ranch	Aug/Sept	Compact shrub, 5-6', with small black berries. Tolerates poor soils; drought tolerant.	Juice, syrup, wine, jam. Great for wildlife.	Pollinate with any other Elderberry on the list.
York	September	Clusters of very large purplish sweet tart berries.	Juice, syrup, wine, jam. Great for wildlife.	Pollinate with any other Elderberry on the list.

OTHER BERRIES 2022

Choke-Berry	Sept/Oct	Wine-black, tannic berries; high in anti-oxidants; tolerant of wet soils; excellent autumn color.	Fresh, preserves, wine, baking, wildlife.	Self-fertile
Goji Berry	Sept/Oct	Sweet/sour; high in anti-oxidants, vitamins and minerals	Fresh, juice, smoothies, teas, dried	Self-fertile
