RASPBERRY

Variety	Type	Berry Size	Qualities	Harvest
Boyne	Summerbearing (Floricanne)	Medium	Dark red, sweet, fragrant. Excellent fresh, frozen or made into jam.	July
Encore	Summerbearing (Floricanne)	Large	Exceptionally sweet red fruit produces on nearly thornless canes. Excellent disease resistance.	August–September
Fall Gold	Everbearing (Primocane)	Large	Very sweet, juicy, golden yellow fruit; Productive variety.	July & September
Glencoe	Everbearing (Primocane)	Large	Tangy, purple fruit, compact grower suitable for containers,	July & September
Heritage	Everbearing (Primocane)	Medium/Large	Upright variety that does not need a trellis; Large crop of dark red, berries; excellent fresh, frozen or made into jam.	July & October
Jewel	Summerbearing (Floricanne)	Very large	Glossy black, rich flavor. Excellent in pies and ja,/ Very productive. Good disease resistance.	July-August
Nova	Summerbearing (Floricanne)	Medium	Bright red fruit, fresh-eating, jam and freezing. Nearly thornless, very good disease resistance. .	August-September

Summerbearing (Floricanne)

Bear fruit on two year old canes in early summer.

Everbearing (Primocane)

Bear fruit on one year old canes in late summer, and on 2 year old canes in early summer.

Boysenberry	Blackberry x Raspberry x Loganberry x Dewberry	Soft, dark maroon fruit; juicy, sweet/tart raspberry-like flavor. Ripens mid- summer.	Trailing; bears fruit on two year old canes	Fresh, frozen, desserts, preserves
Loganberry (Thornless)	Blackberry x Red Raspberry	Soft, deep wine-red fruit with unique tartness, highly flavored; Ripens late summer; long harvest.	Trailing; bears fruit on two year old canes	Preserves, wines & juice, pies
